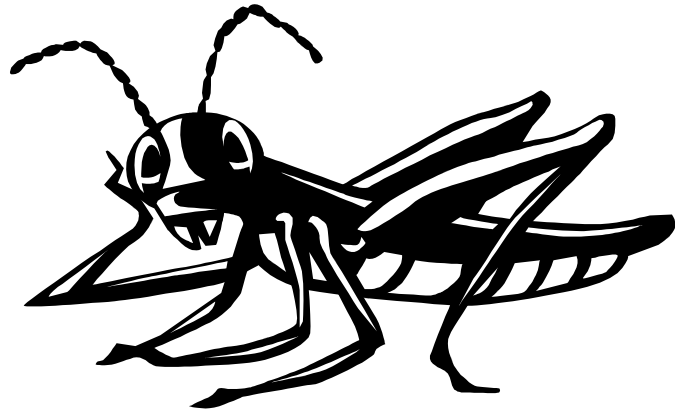




The pioneers walked for 3 months to get to the Salt Lake Valley.

The pioneers prayed and fasted for help.

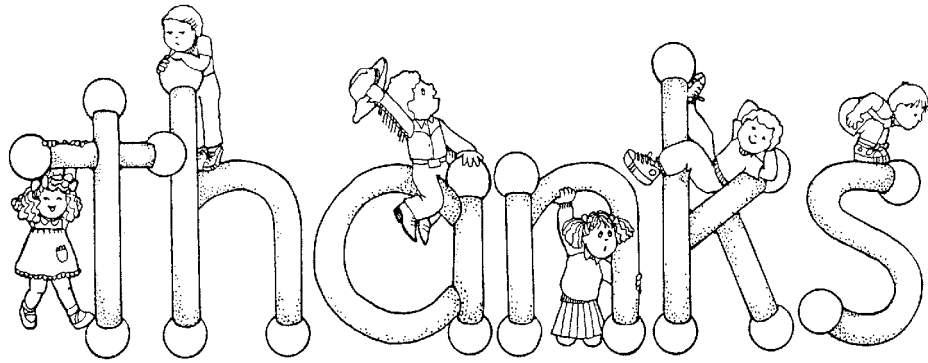


Seagulls came and
