

## **Book of Mormon Trivia Review 1: Introduction to Enos**

Each question answered correctly is worth 10 team points:

1. **True or False: the Title Page to the Book of Mormon says that the words in this book were written for the Lamanites, Jews, and Gentiles.** (True)
2. **Where was the text found that makes up the text of the title page to the Book of Mormon?** (on the last page, Joseph Smith: "The title page of the Book of Mormon is a literal translation taken from the very last leaf, on the left hand side of the collection or book of plates, which contained the record which has been translated, the language of the whole running the same as all Hebrew writing in general (i.e. from right to left); and that said title page is by no means a modern composition.")
3. **The gold plates were buried by** (Moroni).
4. **True or False: the three witnesses to the Book of Mormon were all excommunicated but never denied seeing an angel and the gold plates.** (True, though all three were excommunicated at some point, only David Whitmer remained outside the church at the time of his death, but he continued to bear testimony of the BoM throughout his life.)
5. **The gold plates and other items were found in a box made of stones sealed with some type of cement. On top of the box was a stone with a certain shape. Describe it.** ("This stone was thick and rounding in the middle on the upper side, and thinner towards the edges, so that the middle part of it was visible above the ground, but the edge all around was covered with earth.", Joseph Smith History 1:51)
6. **The youngest person in your group will complete the following statement as best as possible: "And it came to pass that I, Nephi, said unto my father \_\_\_\_.** ("I will go and do the things which the Lord hath commanded, for I know that the Lord giveth no commandments unto the children of men, save he shall prepare a way for them that they may accomplish the thing which he commandeth them." 1 Nephi 3:7)
7. **After chopping off Laban's head, Nephi left Jerusalem with three things. What were they?** (brass plates, sword of Laban, Zoram, *might also accept Laban's clothing*)
8. **True or False: when Nephi broke his bow, Nephi's father, Lehi, was the only person who didn't complain.** (False, 1 Ne 16:20)
9. **True or False: Nephi married before he reached the promised land** (true).
10. **Write the words to the scripture mastery passage 2 Nephi 2:25, word-perfect.** ("Adam fell that men might be, and men are that they might have joy.")
11. **The \_\_\_\_ ransoms men from the Fall of Adam.** (Atonement, 2 Nephi 9:6-7)
12. **True or False: as a result of the Fall, Adam and Eve and their posterity could experience joy and sorrow.** (True, 2 Nephi 2:22-25).
13. **True or False: because of the Fall, we know good and evil.** (True, 2 Nephi 2:22-25).
14. **True or False: the Fall made it possible for us to have children.** (True, 2 Nephi 2:22-25).
15. **Receive 10 points for every symbols and its meaning you can name from the vision of the Tree of Life.** (iron rod – word of god, tree of life – love of God, living waters – love of God, great and spacious building – the pride of the world, fountain of filthy water – depths of hell)
16. **True or False: in 2 Nephi 2:27 we learn that Satan desires that all men should become miserable like he is.** (True)
17. **When the Book of Mormon says "A Bible! A Bible!", what is Nephi prophesying?** (he's seeing the Gentiles in the latter-days saying they have a bible and have no need for any thing else, 2 Nephi 29:3-6)

18. **Another name for Jacob 5 is the** (Olive Tree Allegory, see chapter header).
19. **True or False: Enos was swimming when he decided to pray.** (False, he was hunting, Enos 1:3)
20. **Name two things for which Enos prayed.** (his own sins, his fellow Nephites, the Lamanites, the records, see Enos 1).

**BONUS QUESTION - On the sword of Laban were engraved some words. 50 points if you can quote all or part of it.** (“This sword will never be sheathed again until The Kingdoms of this world become the Kingdom of our God and his Christ“, according to Brigham Young, JD 19:38)
