Agency and Accountability

Each team needs to tell who the story is about and a summary of the story. The following details should be included. Each member must tell one of the stories and then anyone can answer the rest once each person has had a turn.

- 1. Lehi's dream of the iron rod leading to the Tree of Life.
- 2. The liahona led them, by their faith, across the waters.
- 3. King Benjamin built a tower to testify of Christ to his people.
- 4. Ammon cut the arms off of those trying to steal the king's sheep. He was on a mission to the Lamanites.
- 5. Samuel the Lamanite stood on the city wall testifying of the coming of Christ while the Nephites shot arrows at him.
- 6. The Title of Liberty was made by Captain Moroni.
- 7. The Golden Plates made by Mormon, finished by Moroni, translated by Joseph Smith.

Points – The team receives a point for each story told.

Wrap-up — Each of these people had agency to choose whether or not to do what God asked them to do. You will never be asked to stand on a wall and testify of Christ while people shoot arrows at you like Samuel. Or go on a mission to a land where the people will most likely kill you, like Ammon. Or leave everything and move your family without knowing where you're going, like Lehi. But "you are responsible for the choices you make. You should not blame your circumstances, your family, or your friends if you choose to disobey God's commandments. You are a child of God with great strength. You have the ability to choose righteousness and happiness, no matter what your circumstances."
