Among the events we remember are the appearance of Jesus Christ, Moses, Elijah, and Elias at the Kirtland Temple on April 3, 1836 (D&C 110); Jewish Passover; the Crucifixion and Resurrection of Jesus Christ; and Christ's appearance to the Nephites. The April 1975 General Conference was the first time that satellites were used to broadcast conference meetings. At that time, conference lasted 3 days. Many important events have occurred on April 6, including the organization of the church, the St. George temple dedication, the Salt Lake temple dedication, the sustaining of many general authorities, and many more. LDS Church members also believe that April 6 is the actual birth day of Jesus Christ (D&C 20:1).
