

Class Presidency Meeting

- You should hold regular meetings to plan how to fulfil your responsibilities and to receive leadership training. The young women presidency member attends these meetings also.
- If you have councillors you can take it in turns to conduct this meeting - you should seek counsel, suggestions and guidance from your young women leader who is responsible for your class.

The agenda might include the following:

- Plan how you can fulfil your responsibilities. Review the needs of individual class members and plan how to help meet those needs. Plan visits to class members as needed.
- Discuss ways to encourage private religious behaviour (such as scripture study, prayer and journal writing) through Sunday instruction and personal progress.
- Plan the class's work in accomplishing the mission statement of the Church: helping people come unto Christ by proclaiming the gospel perfecting the saints and redeeming the dead.
- Plan class meetings. Plan mutual activities, including service activities and combined Aaronic Priesthood - Young Women activities.
- Plan group experiences for Personal Progress.
- Prepare agenda items for Bishopric Youth Committee meeting.
- Receive reports from those who have been given assignments. Give new assignments.
- Receive leadership training.
