

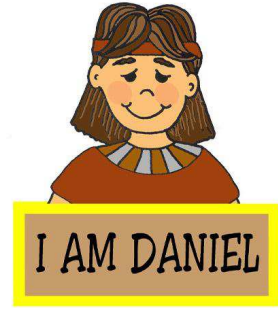
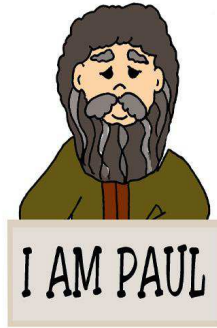
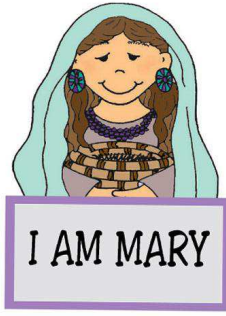
February 2012: Sharing Time

Week 2

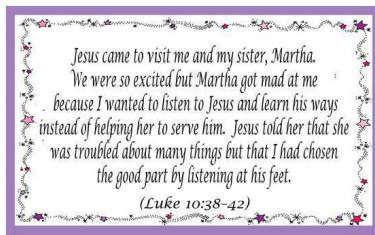
Jesus' disciples were blessed by choosing the right

I was changed immediately and asked what the Lord would have me do. Even so, when I arose from the ground, I was without sight and did not eat or drink for three days.

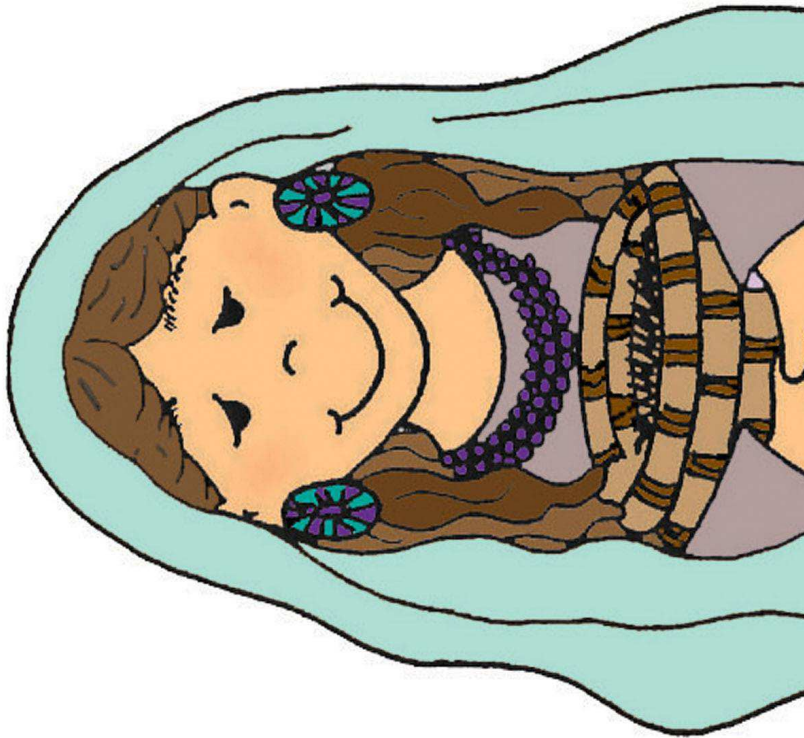

the good part by listening at his feet.

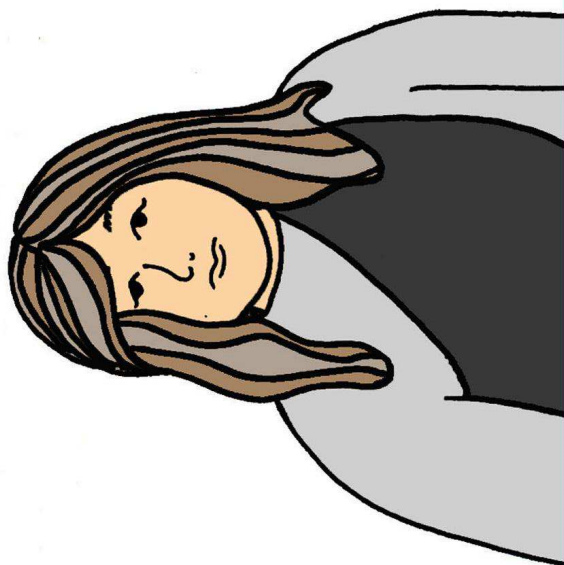

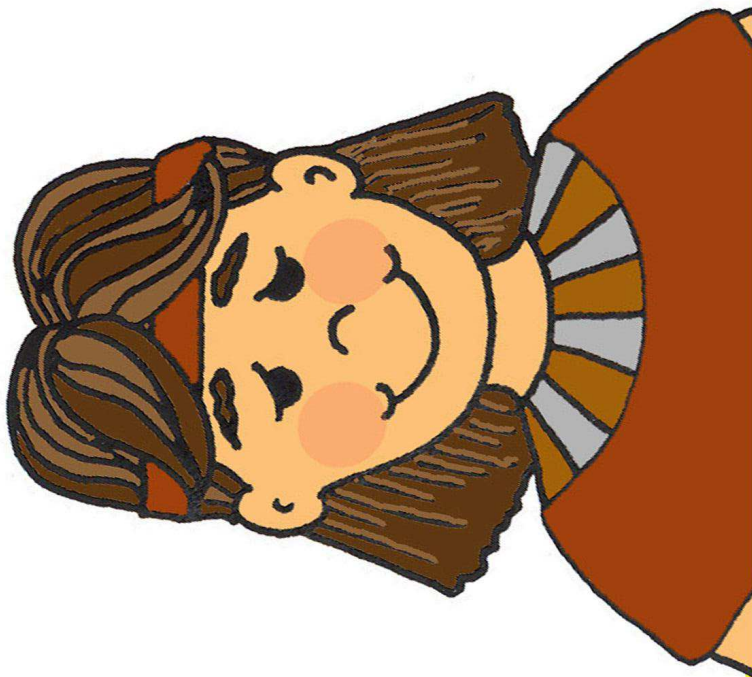
