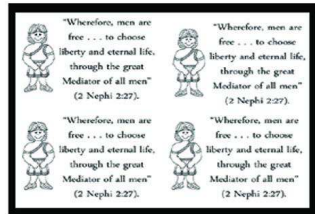
Agency Is the Gift to Choose for Ourselves

Encourage understanding (learning scripture stories):

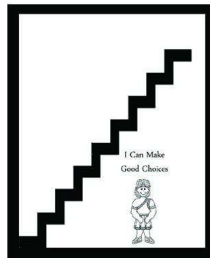

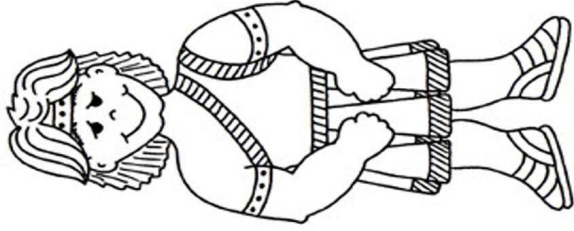
Encourage application (hearing a story)

1. Stairs (See Attached Sheet)

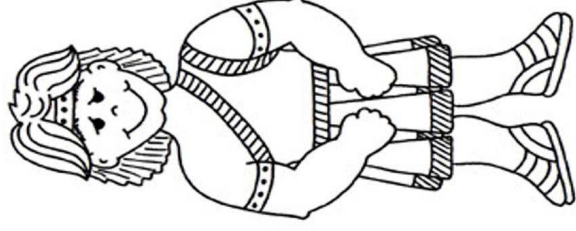
2. Boy or Girl to climb the stairs and sample questions. (Full list of questions found in the "Choose the Right" Packet)



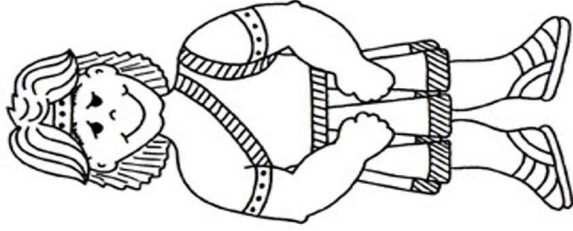
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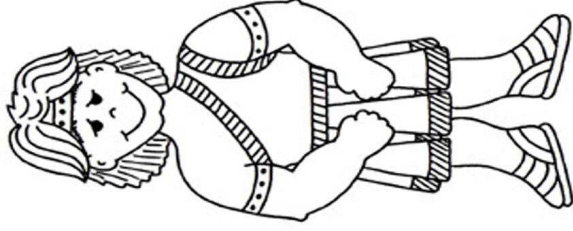
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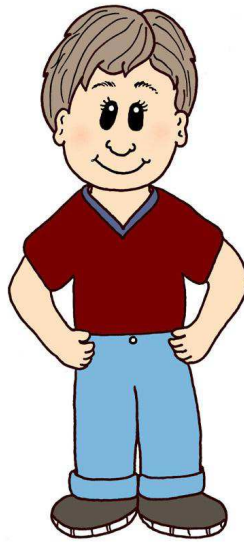
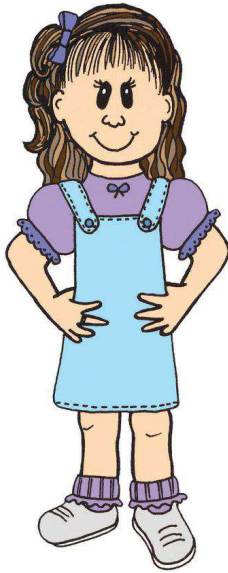


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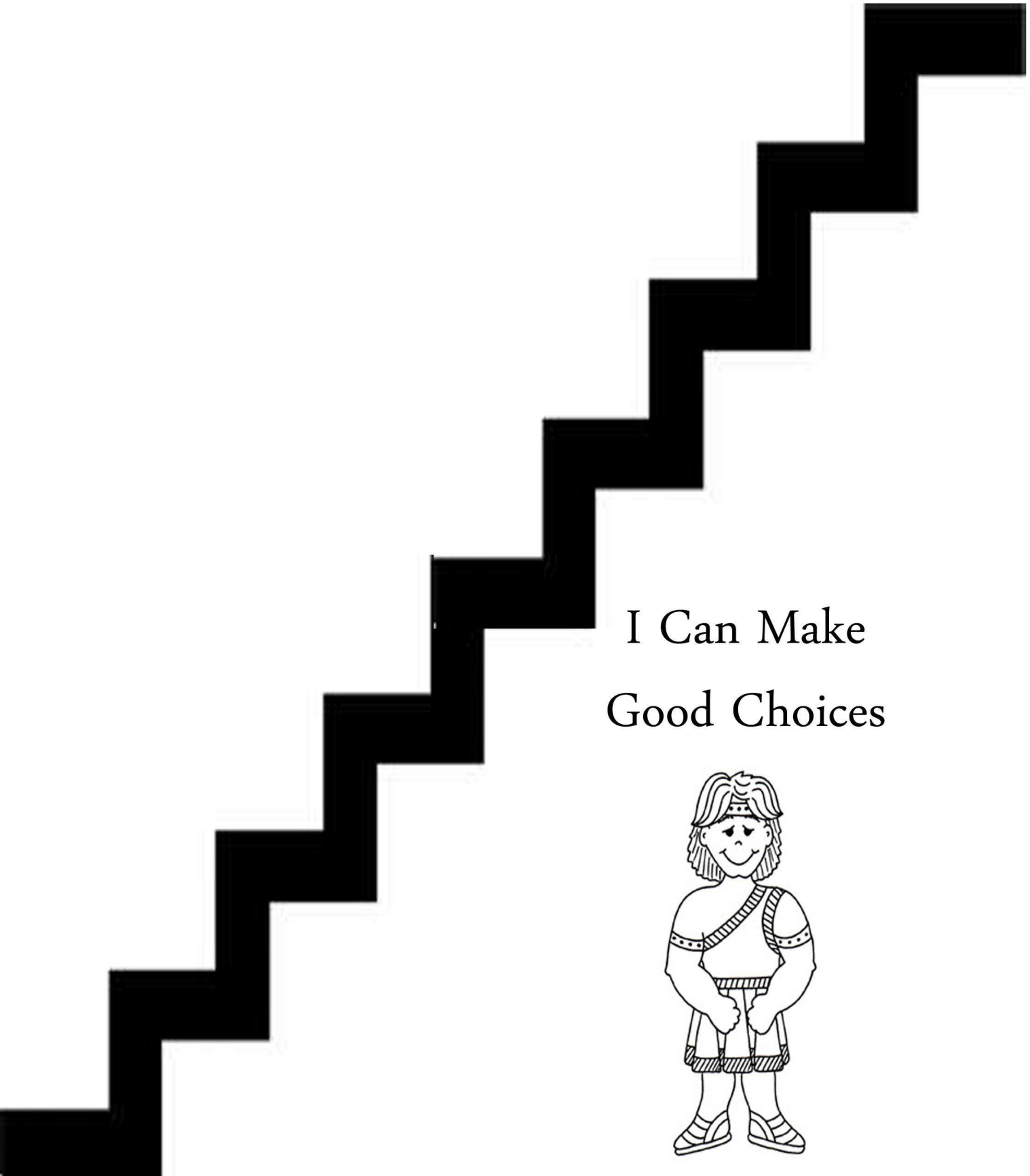
