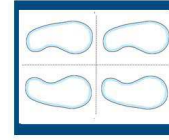
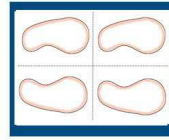
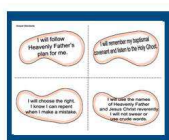
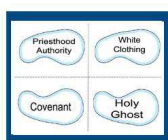
Week 1: "I will follow Jesus Christ by being baptized and confirmed and keeping my baptismal covenants."

Preparation:

- Print and cut out all the footprints. The official footprints can be found at sharingtime.lds.org. I have included footprints that are similar to the ones found on lds.org. The footprints I have attached are just a little larger, color coordinated, and arranged so you can use a paper cutter rather than cutting them all by hand. I have also written in the gospel standards on the color coordinated footprints.
- Cut out the sheet of cards. (see attached)
- Print out the sign and the list of gospel standards. (see attached)



Identify the Doctrine:



Follow the official outline using the foot prints. I have attached a sign to hang above the large footprints. There are also blank foot prints to be used as needed. Teach the children a small lesson on Baptism. If needed we have a packet on Baptism that can be used as a reference, or use your own materials.

Additional Activity:

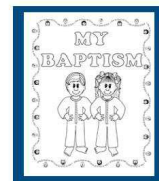
- Taking Good Steps Activity:** This activity illustrates how we are trying to take steps towards the Savior. Each team will be reading cards that focus on the gospel standards. These cards will either have them take a step forward or backward.
- For this activity you will need a starting and ending point. I would suggest using the board with a picture of the Savior as the ending point and the back of the room as the beginning, letting the children walk down the center aisle.
- Split the primary into two teams.
- Have the first team draw a card. Each card will describe a characteristic of shoes. Pick a child that matches that characteristic on the team to go first. For instance it might say, "A child with purple shoes," so pick a child with purple shoes and have them start by going to the back of the room. Side note: You might need to adjust the descriptions if you don't have someone who meets the outlined criteria. You can simply name a different color, size, etc.
- Have them follow the cards instructions by either taking steps forward or backward. After the children take their steps, teach about that gospel standard. Each card has a number that correlates with a number on the "My gospel standards" sheet that I have attached.
- Draw another card. Once a new child is chosen, have them replace the previous child by standing where they were. The teams continue racing until one team reaches the front.



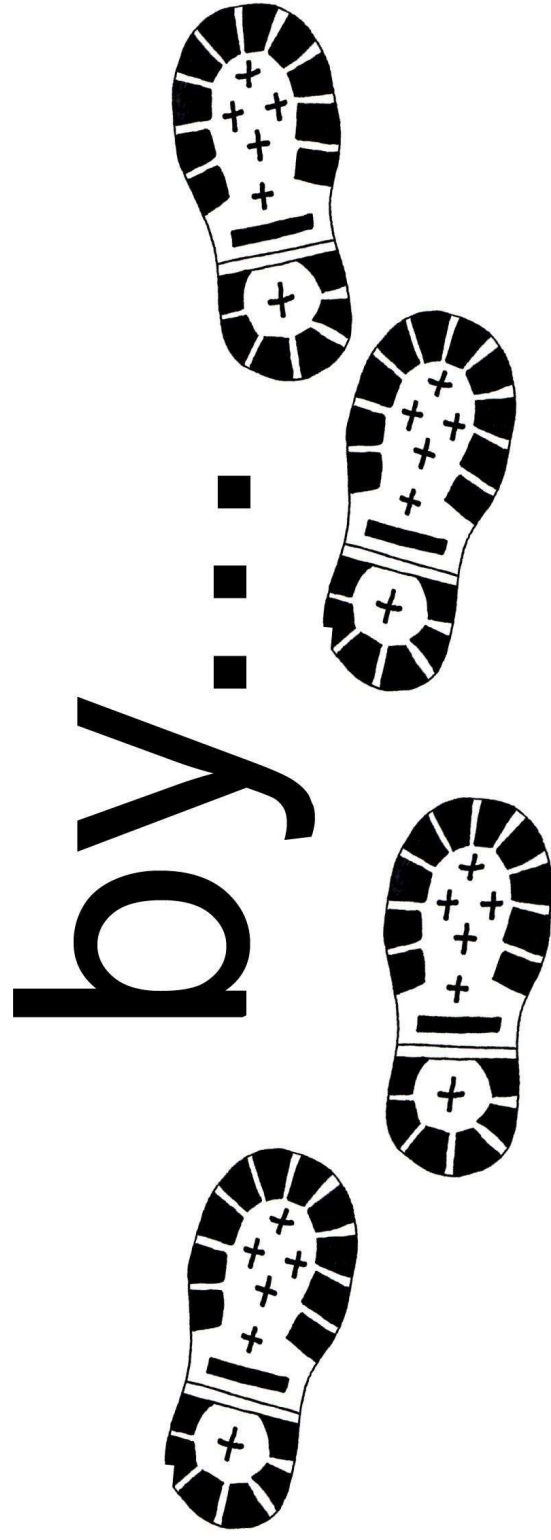
