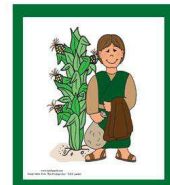


Week 4: "When I repent, I can be forgiven"

Identify the doctrine: Follow the official outline as directed. I have attached the sheet of words to be printed and cut out for the classes. You can also turn this into a larger group activity.

- Print and cut out word strips.
- Hide the words all around the room.
- Call on one child at a time to try to find a hidden word. Have the child place it on the board.
- Repeat until all the words are found and on the board.
- Call on children to come forward and try to put them in the correct order.

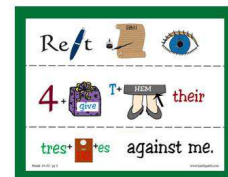
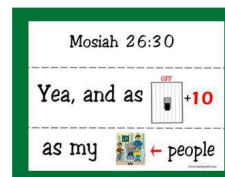


Encourage understanding:

- Teach the story of the prodigal son. I have attached a graphic of the prodigal son in case you do not have access to the official picture from the gospel art picture set.
- Follow the outline by teaching actions. We also have all the graphics and story in our "Prodigal Son" F.H.E. packet.

Encourage application:

- Print and cut out the word strips of Mosiah 26:30.
- Give each class or mini group one wordstrip.
- Have them try to figure out what it says by looking at the picture clues.
- Slowly read Mosiah 26:30. Tell the groups to stand when you read their part of the scripture.
- Have someone from that group come forward and tape their word strip to the board.
- When the entire scripture is taped to the board, repeat the scripture and teach the meaning by following the outline.



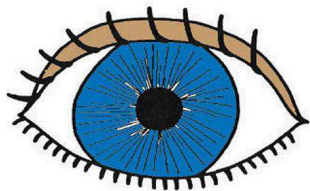
