Two weeks before pass out the baby picture reminder cards and then secretly call the parents to fill in their full name, birth date, birthplace & a feminine quality.

That evening have a lacy tablecloth and flowers on the table with the ladybug decorations. Setup a garden arch or drape a doorway with white tulle & white lights to be used as a *grand entrance*..



Collect the YW baby pictures & place them on a table with a # on a sticky note below. Then have a leader fill in an answer sheet with names of the young women by the #s. Pass out a numbered piece of paper to each young woman and have her guess names.

Later have the young women pickup their baby picture & by number order send each girl one at a time out into the hallway to walk in for her *grand entrance and announcement*. Play music CD softly.....

While each young woman walks in one at a time holding her baby picture posing like in a pageant, present each girl like at a Debutant Ball slowly and gracefully by announcing their full name Miss......., announce their birthday, birth place And 1 nurturing or feminity fact about them from the 'Lovely Ladybug Notes'.

Finally all girls in a line like a pageant now explain to the girls that their family thought that they were the most beautiful little girls in the world and felt so blessed to bring them into their homes. Heavenly Father sent us as beautiful baby GIRLS into the world at this time because he knows us so well. Have YW sit down.

LADYBUG CHARM CRAFT:



Have girls string onto the jute their glass ladybug bead. Available from Oriental Trading Now have them tie 2 slipknots (1st part of tying a bow) to make an adjustable bracelet.
