

Fun: 1. Carefree Amusement – a time or feeling of enjoyment
 2. Mockery – playful joking, often at the expense of another
 3. Cheap & Flamboyant – flamboyant in style and often made of cheap synthetic materials, designed to be used or worn for fun

Satisfaction: 1. Gratification – the feeling of pleasure that comes when a need or desire is fulfilled
 2. Fulfillment – the fulfillment of a need or desire
 3. Compensation – compensation for an injury or loss

Happiness: 1. Causing Pleasure – causing or characterized by pleasure, contentment, or joy
 2. Willing – willing to do something
 3. Fortunate (or we would say Blessed) – resulting in something pleasant or welcome
 4. Used to express Hope in Greetings such as “Happy Birthday”

Joy: 1. Great Happiness – feelings of great happiness or pleasure, especially of an elevated or spiritual kind
 2. Rejoice or Gladden – to derive joy from something or to give somebody joy
 3. Enjoy – to delight in or enjoy something
