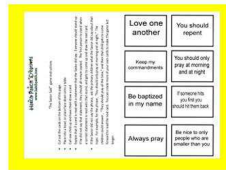
Week 1: "Jesus Christ taught the gospel and set an example for us"

Identify the doctrine:

- Sing "Do as I'm doing," and have 3 or 4 children come up during the song and have each child pick a different action. Let the primary children choose which child's action they will do during the song. Emphasize that we have a choice who we follow and who we don't.
- Play a game called, "The Savior Said." See the attached page for instructions.

Encourage Understanding:

Preparation

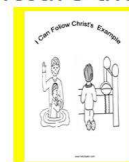


- Take three solid colored drinking glasses and turn them upside-down on the table.
- Crinkle up the scripture reference cards into balls. (See attached cards)
- Follow the outline by placing the Gospel Art Pictures on the board. The church has counseled us not to draw cartoon images of the savior. For this reason, I do not have the needed graphics. However, if you do not have access to the Gospel Art Picture kit, I am attaching graphics that show what the concept is, but not of the savior teaching it. If you can track down the official pictures it would be better.



Activity

- Explain that to follow an example we must first watch what they are doing. Place one of the scripture reference crinkled balls under one of the cups while the children are watching.
- Call a child up and have them follow the cup with their eyes as you slide the cups around each other on the table. (I am hoping everyone has seen this or played this game before. If not, you should get out more. Ha, ha, ha)
- Have them guess which cup has the crumpled scripture reference under it. Lift up the cup. If they are correct they get to read the scripture or you can read it for them. Once the scripture is read call up a different child to point to the correct picture that matches the reference.
- Continue to play through all the scripture references.



Encourage Application

"The Savior Said" game instructions

- Cut out the cards on the bottom of this page.
- Place into a bowl or place face-down on a table.
- Call one child up and have them draw a card.
- Explain that if a card is read with a statement that the Savior did say, everyone should stand up. If he did not say that statement, they should all remain seated. The first person to stand when a correct statement is read wins that round, and gets to come up and draw the next card.
- If the Savior did not say the phrase, ask the primary children what the Savior did say about that topic. For example, for the phrase, "You should only pray at morning and at night," the children could answer, "They should pray all the time," and then that child gets to come forward to read the next card. You can create more of your own cards to make the game last longer.

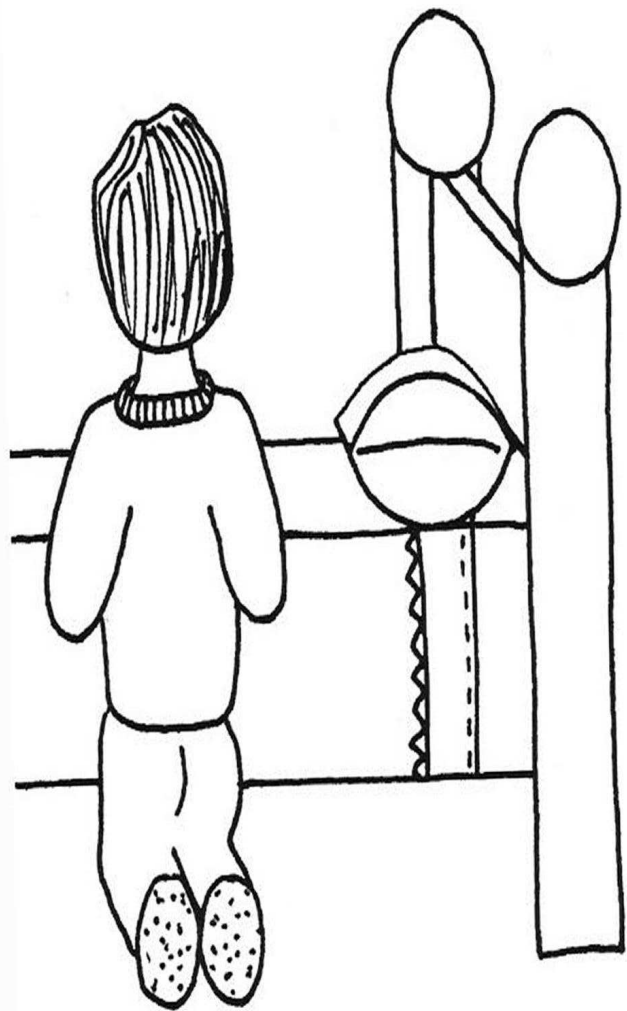
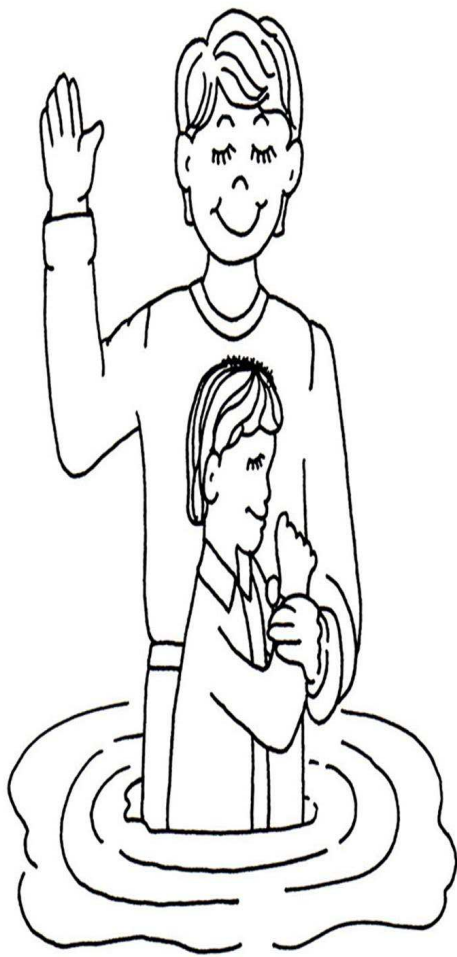
