

Sharing Time March 2013

Week 3: "Because Jesus Christ was resurrected, I will be too"

Identify the Doctrine: Tell the story of the Resurrection. You can use our "Easter" FHE packet as a reference or read directly from the scriptures.

- Teach the concept of the resurrection by showing your hand which represents your spirit.
- Show a glove that represents your body. Show how they can be reunited.
- Have the children repeat, "Because Jesus Christ was resurrected, I will be too." I have attached a sign to help the junior primary repeat the statement.
- If you want to be an over-achiever, purchase disposable latex gloves from the store (you might want to check and make sure you don't have any children with Latex allergies). Write on each glove with a permanent marker: "I will be resurrected like Jesus." Give a glove to each child.

Encourage Understanding:

Print out the cards that have the happy/sad faces on them










- Hand a card out to each child or if you have a large primary, hand out the cards to as many as you have time for.
- Place the two signs on the board, "Death" and "Resurrection."
- Ask the children to say a word that describes how the disciples felt when Jesus died. I have
 included a list of suggestions if they need a little extra help. When a child answers have them
 come to the front of the room and place their sad face card under "Death." Continue accepting
 answers until all the sad cards are under death.
- Teach the children about the joy of the resurrection. Ask them to give a word that shows the joy the disciples felt when they learned of the resurrection. Give them the examples from the outline "happiness, joy, hope, etc. When a child answers, they get to come up and flip the card the opposite way and place it on the "resurrection" side.
- Encourage Application:


Follow the instructions listed in the outline. Have the children come forward and talk about a loved one they have lost. Hand them the large happy /sad face. Have them show it as sad as they say who has died. Have them flip it over and complete the sentence mentioned in the outline, "I am thankful Jesus was resurrected because...". Give each child a card to take home and teach their families about the Resurrection.

Additional Ideas: There is a great story and graphics in our "Plan of Salvation" packet that you can teach. There is also a "Sorry" game that can be tweaked to use in Senior Primary sharing time if you need more material.




























Feeling Words

Happiness Bliss


