

“PRESIDENT’S AWARD”

REQUIREMENTS



To receive the President’s Award you need to have 100% attendance. This is done by simply being there every day (or by making up every day missed to equal 100% attendance). The following are ways to makeup absences:

- Be perfectly on time for 7 consecutive seminary days after the absence occurred = 1 day makeup.
- Read in your scriptures 5 consecutive days for 10 minutes and write down something you learned each day = 1 day makeup.
- Pass off to your teacher 2 Scripture Mastery scriptures (can’t use the same scripture twice) = 1 day makeup.
- Memorize the current First Presidency and Quorum of the Twelve = 1 day makeup.
- Memorize that year’s scripture books in order. (For D&C, memorize the modern prophets in order) = 1 day makeup.
- Turn in one page of notes for every hour of General Conference you listened to = 1 day makeup.
- Do two chapters in the Student Study Guide and study the corresponding chapters in the scriptures = 1 day makeup.

Absences from past years can only be made up with the last two options.
Presidents Awards can never be earned after the school year is over.

NOTE: *Tardiness Counts!* Flagrant tardies count as absences in the following ways: Three days of 15 minutes late; Two of 25 minutes late, etc... All give you one absence to makeup. In other words, “Time for Time”.
