

### September Sharing Time: Week 1

We are blessed when we keep the commandments.

Identify the Doctrine: While talking about rules that we have to keep us safe, show the enclosed Road signs. Have the children try to identify them and tell why we have them. (To help us be safe)

Here is another object lesson I have done before. Call a child to the front of the room. (One of the louder kids usually works better for this....oh come on! I know every primary has one.) Tell them you are going to give them some guidelines. Then proceed to give them rules. You can make up a number of rules such as; don't run in the street, don't talk to strangers etc. Make sure one of the rules is, "Don't open your mouth." Then ask them to close their eyes and open their mouth. I have found that most kids will open their mouth out of curiosity. (You might have to help tempt them to open their mouth) Then with a spray bottle, squirt pure lemon juice into their mouths. Then explain that we are given rules for our safety and happiness. Even if we are tempted we need to stick to the rules.














Encourage understanding (singing songs): Set up a game of "Name that Tune." Place the Category Stones (see attached) on one side of the board. On the other side, attach the song stones. Have the pianist start to play or have someone hum one of the songs. Have everyone raise their hand when they know the song. Continue until everyone knows it. The first person who guesses the song gets to come up and move the "song stone" to the correct category. Then sing the song all together.




