1. Cub Scout Application Form: You will need to fill out this form and return it to your scout leader as soon as possible. No advancements can be awarded without this form being completed.
2. You will need to purchase the following items from the scout office: Cub Scout Shirt, Neckerchief, slide, Wolf Book, Belt. Other items are available but not required. If you have any problem affording these items, please speak with your scout leader. Many times we have donations from former scouts made available.

3. We meet in our den once a week for den meeting. Our den meetings are held: _____.

5. Advancements in the scouting program and Faith In God program are primarily the responsibility of the scout and his family. However, we often do activities in our den which correlate with one or both.
6. The first thing you should work on with your new scout is his Bobcat. Instructions for earning the Bobcat are located at the front of the Wolf Book. The Bobcat is easily earned and must be obtained before any other advancements may be awarded.

Because Pack _____ is sponsored by the LDS Church, we are asked to incorporate the LDS values and principles of the Gospel that we feel will help your boy become a young man of integrity and a worthy priesthood holder. If you have any concerns about this, please see the Bishop of the _____ Ward.
