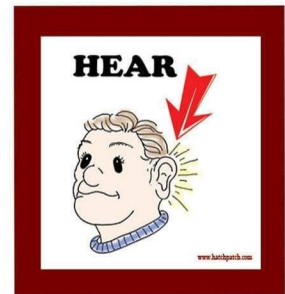
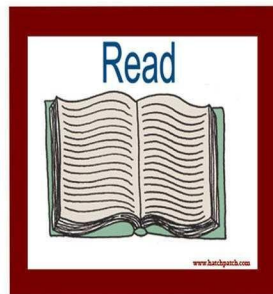
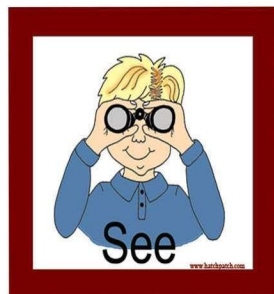
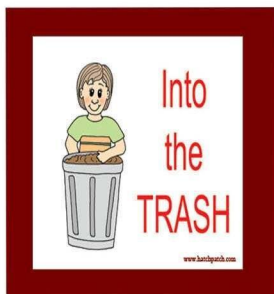


## Sharing Time: August Week 2

### Idea #1

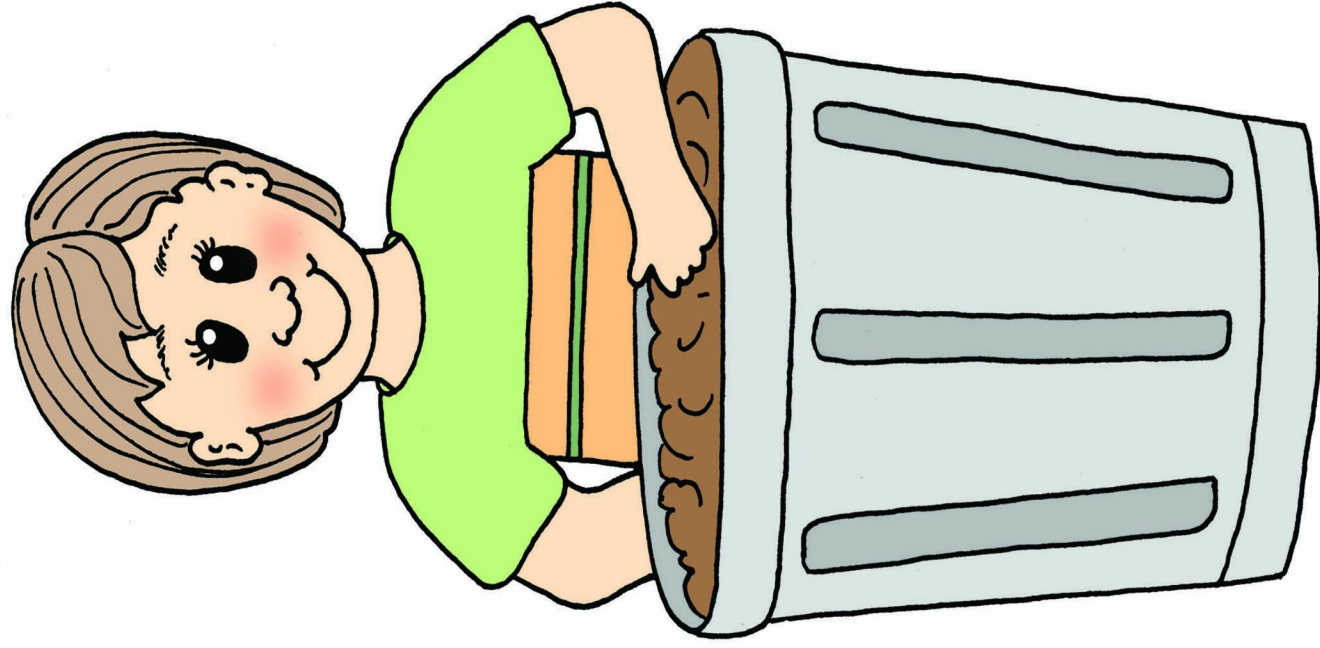
Place the four graphics (Look, Listen, Hear and Trash) on the board. Place the listed items in a bag or simply cut out word strip and place them in a bag. (see attached) Have one child pick an item/word strip. Have that child place the item where it goes under the correct sign. Take the time to talk about each item and why they made that choice.



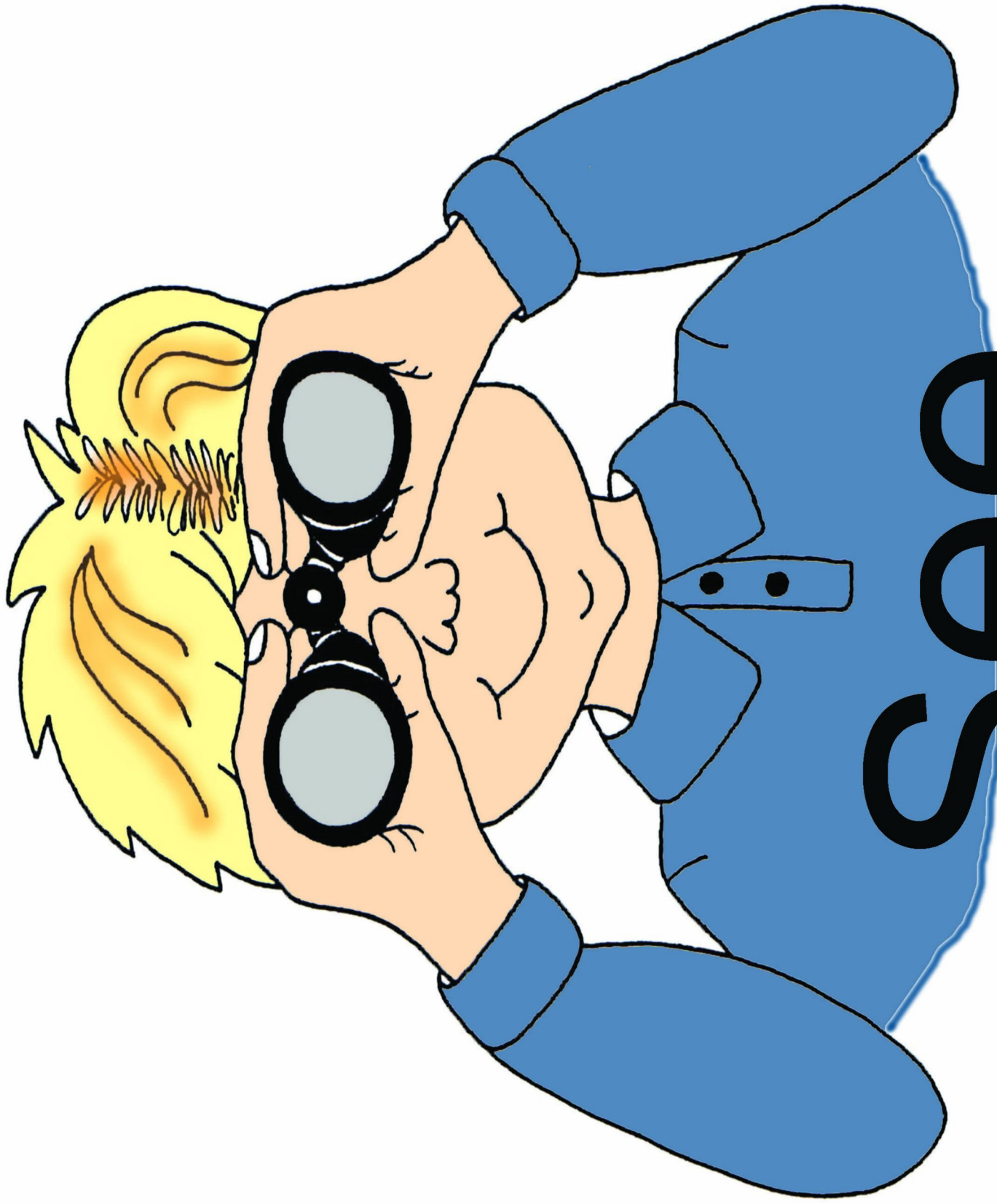
### Idea #2

Teach the children hand actions for Read, (like holding a book) Listen, (hand cupping ear) Look, (looking through glasses) and Trash. (throw something over their shoulder) Break the primary into three different groups. Bring one child from each group to the front of the room. Read an item from the list. (see attached) The first child to do the correct action; Look, Listen, Hear or Trash receives one point for their team. Play as time allows, taking the opportunity to explain why some things belong in the trash while others are good for us.





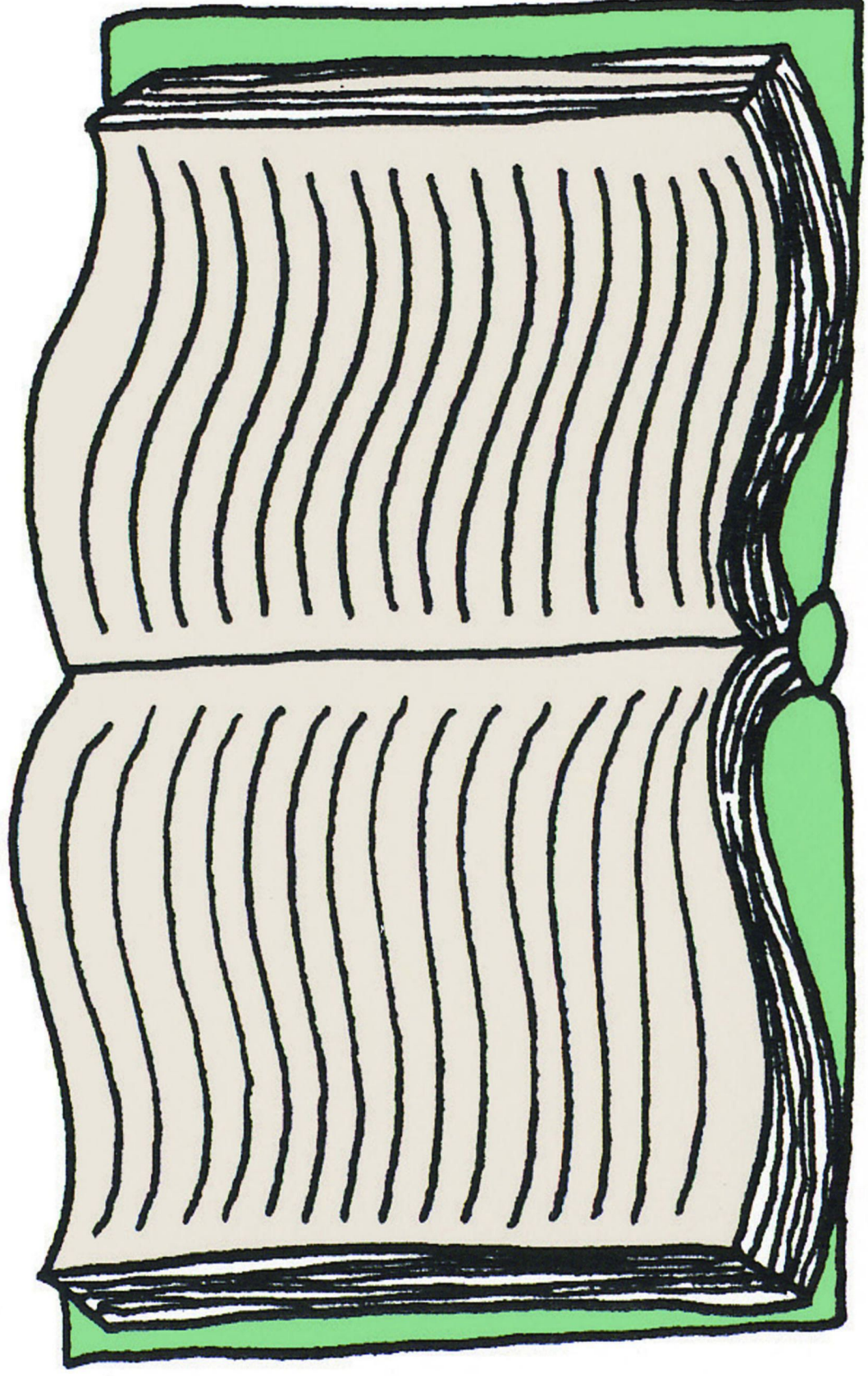

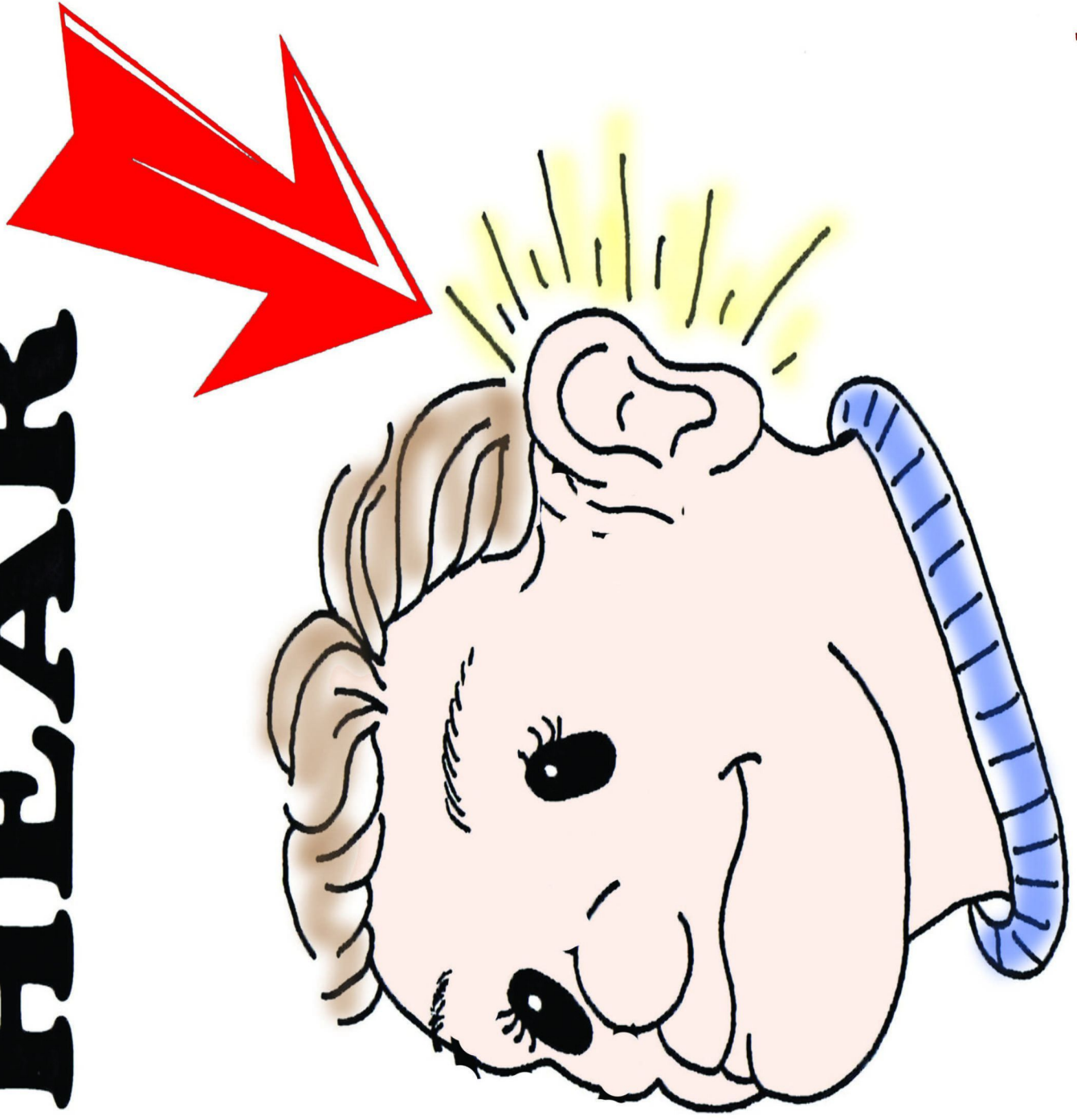
