

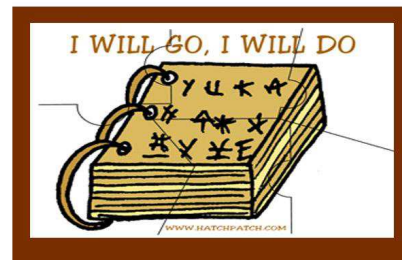
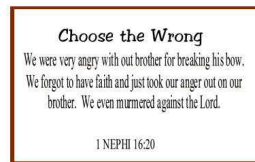
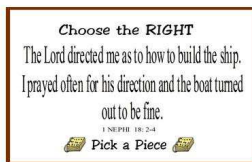
# February 2012: Sharing Time

*Encourage Understanding: Cut "I will go, I will do puzzle" into pieces. (see attached) Also cut "Choose the Right" and "Choose the Wrong" cards. (see attached) Call on one child at a time to come up. Have them draw a card and read it out loud (or read it for them if needed).*



*Tell the story in more detail, or for senior primary have them turn to the scripture reference found on the card. If it was a "right" choice then they can draw a piece of the puzzle and put it on the board. For the "Choose the Wrong" card they do not get to put up a piece. If you need the game to go on longer, you can have them take off a piece for bad choice cards. Continue to play until the entire puzzle is built. You can create your own cards or use the attached ones.*

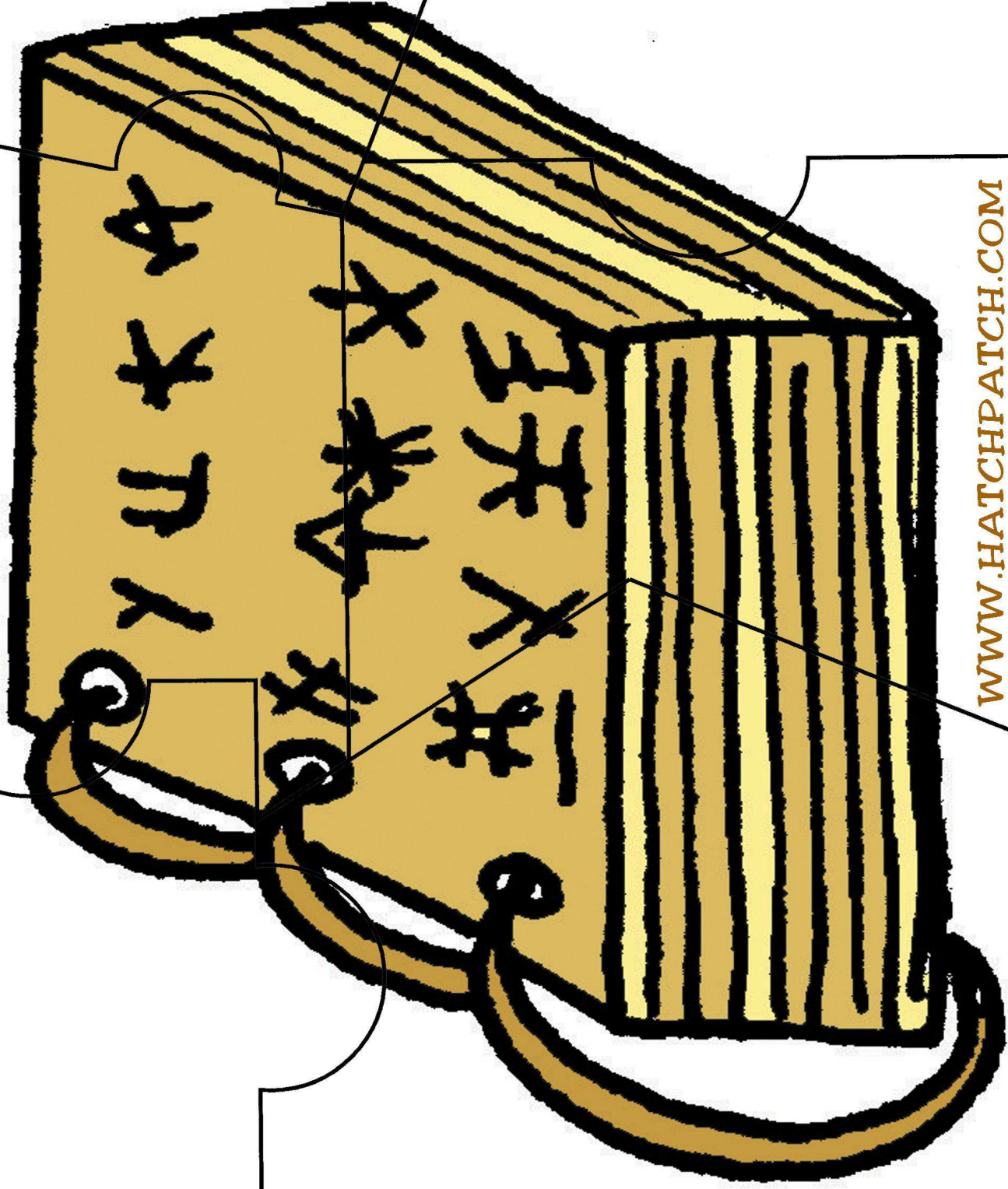
