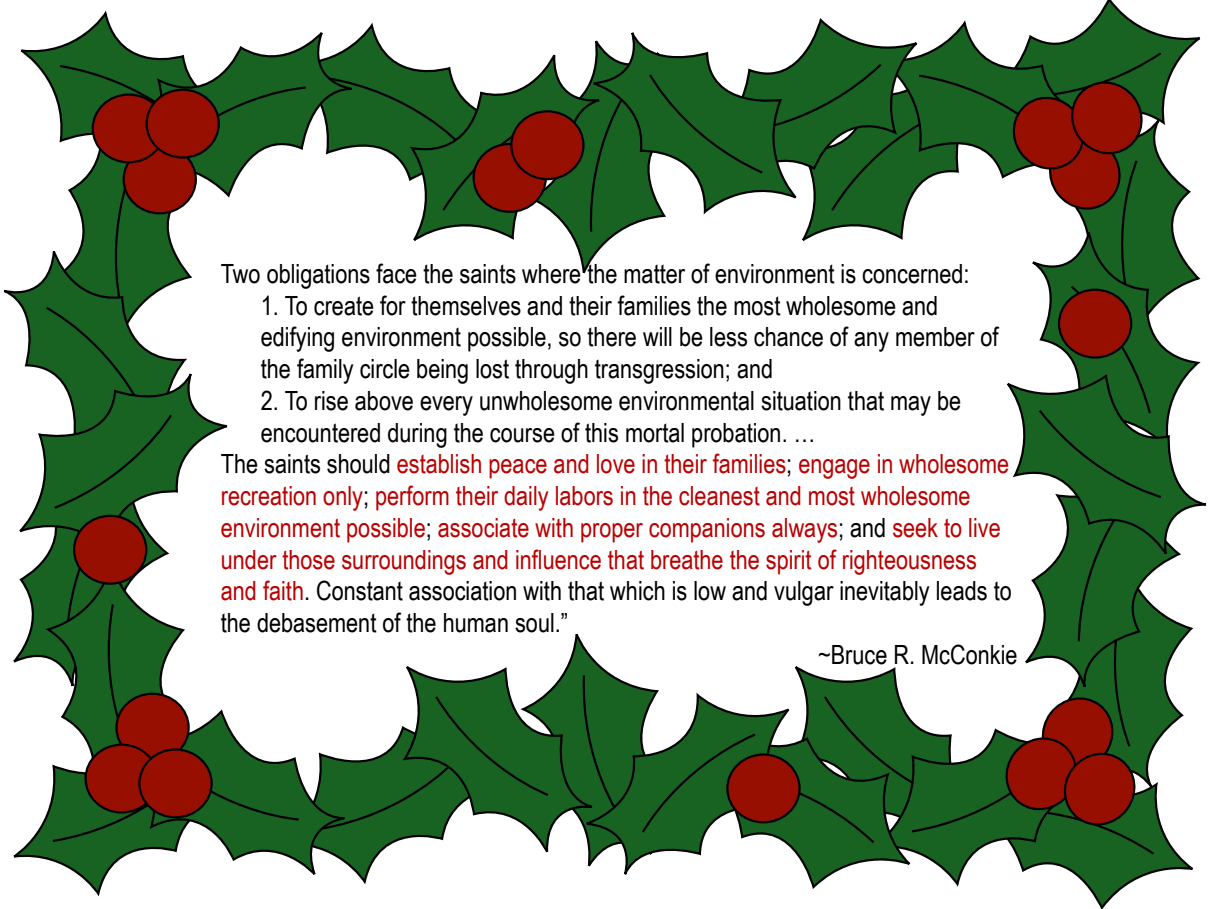


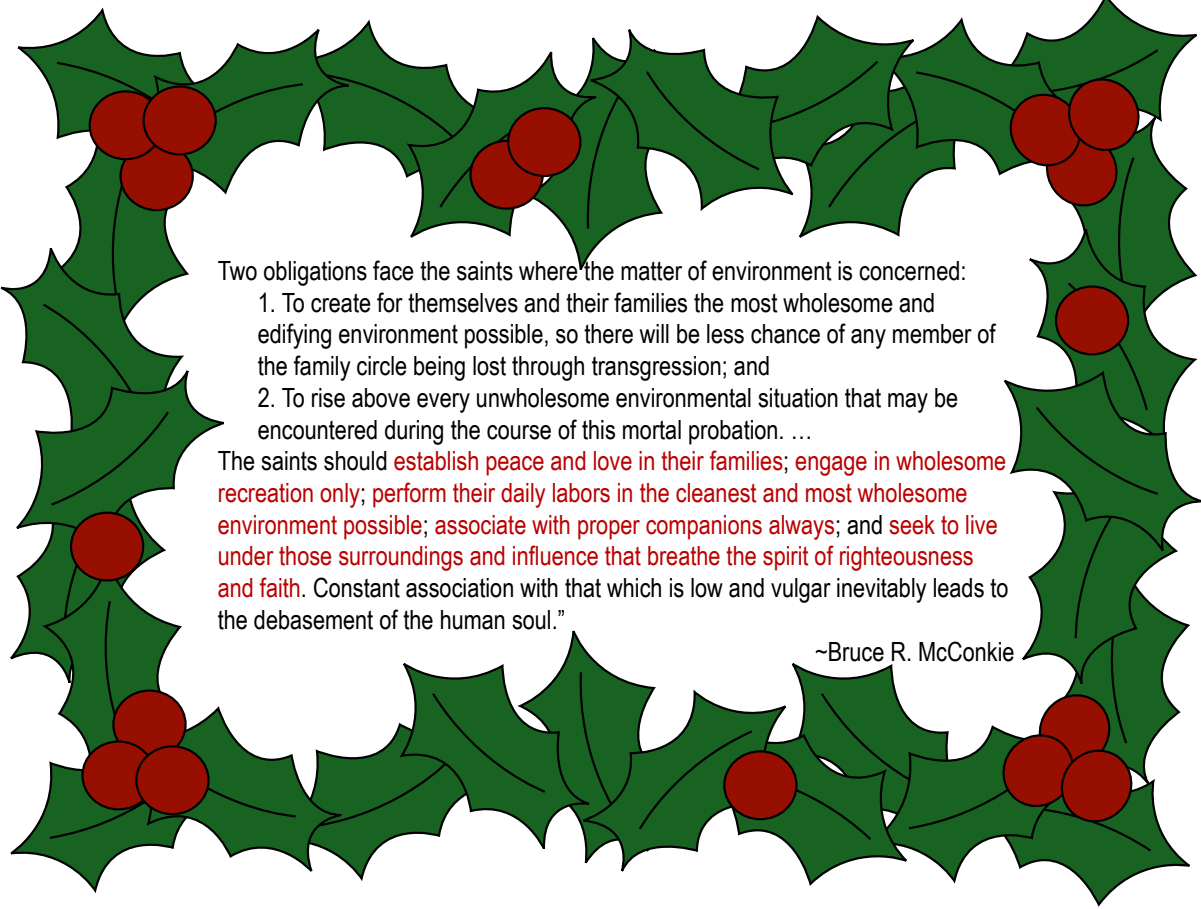


Two obligations face the saints where the matter of environment is concerned:

2. To rise above every unwholesome environmental situation that may be encountered during the course of this mortal probation. ...

The saints should **establish peace and love in their families; engage in wholesome recreation only; perform their daily labors in the cleanest and most wholesome environment possible; associate with proper companions always; and seek to live under those surroundings and influence that breathe the spirit of righteousness and faith.** Constant association with that which is low and vulgar inevitably leads to the debasement of the human soul."

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
