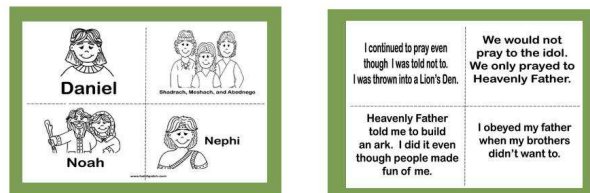


November Sharing Time 2012

Week 2 “I can be a missionary by setting a good example”

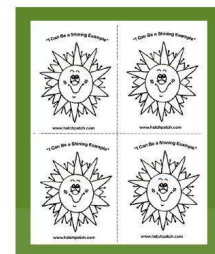
Identify the Doctrine: Object Lesson: I love the block idea. If you don't happen to have blocks you could also use a puzzle. Bring a child up to the front. Then empty the puzzle pieces on to the table. Ask them to build it. They will probably ask for the picture. If they don't, explain how much easier it is to build if you have an example.

Encourage Understanding: Place the four “Clue” cards down one side of the board. On the other side of the board place the 4 picture clues. Bring up a child and have them read the first clue. Have them find the match to the correct person on the other side. Either attach yarn to connect them or simply draw on the black board. After each match is made, teach that particular scripture story. Emphasize the importance of setting a good example.



Passing the sun: Everything is better with sugar. Fill a bowl with Starbursts. Tape the sun picture (see attached) to the bowl. When the music stops have them share how they have been an example. Then let them pick out a starburst.

Hand out the Sun cards for them to take home.
