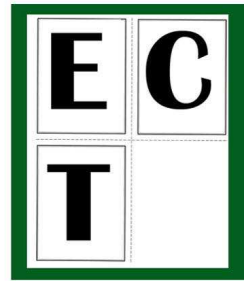


Sharing Time: September Week 2

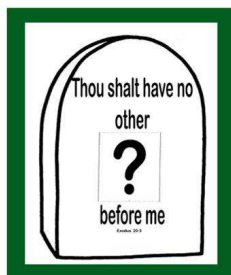
I should respect and worship God.

Introduction: Print and cut out the letters that spell RESPECT. Mix them up in a bowl or hat. Have the children draw one letter at a time and put it on the board. They will be all jumbled up. See if the children can guess the word. Once they do, define the word. Explain how today we will be finding out how we can respect and worship God.



Review the story of Moses receiving the commandments.

Place the four Commandment stones on the board. (See attached) Cut out the missing word squares. (See attached) Roll up the words and place inside balloons. It is significantly easier to place the papers in the balloons before you blow them up. Ha ha ha Have a child come to the front of the room. Have them pop the balloon with a thumb tack. If they try with their feet you might end up with a reverence problem. Once they get their clue have them read it and then sit down. Call up another child to find where it goes and place it in the correct box. Teach about each commandment and ask "How we can live this commandment." Continue through all four commandments.
