
Week 3: "I can receive strengthening power through priesthood blessings."

Encourage Understanding:

I actually liked the idea in the Sharing time Outline. I thought it would be slightly easier however, to hand out "hand cards" and let the kids put their names on them rather than trying to trace and cut out that many kids hands. Then follow the outline as listed.







Additional ideas.

Since this activity was all about using our hands, I came up with a few additional activities you could do.

- 1. Read the scenario sheet. See which child can raise their hand the fastest when a scenario is read that illustrates being strengthened through the priesthood.
- 2. Split the kids into two groups. Call 1 from each team up at a time. Have them play slap jack with the cards enclosed. When a card comes up that illustrates the priesthood blessing that blesses someone's life see who can slap it first. You can also print the cards to give as a handout to play at home.
