Object of the Game: The object of the game is to finish with the LOWEST score (fewest putts per hole).

Game Rules: Each hole will be in different rooms at the church (see map on reverse). All family teams will be divided into groups/start hole number. A "shotgun" start will mean that all of group A will start together, each family team beginning at a different hole. That group will complete the course, and then group B will play, etc., until all families have played the course. The course will be played with a "best ball" score. Write the BEST (lowest) score for each hole in the appropriate column in the BEST SCORE row. This evens out the scoring of the game, regardless of how many people are in the family team. Space has been provided if you wish to keep score for each person in your family just for fun.
